Schedule 5 – Operating Reserve – Spinning Reserve Service

Spinning Reserve Service is needed to serve load immediately in the event of a system contingency. Spinning Reserve Service may be provided by generating units that are on-line and loaded at less than maximum output and by non-generation resources capable of providing this service. The Transmission Provider must offer this service when the transmission service is used to serve load within its Control Area. The Transmission Customer must either purchase this service from the Transmission Provider or make alternative comparable arrangements to satisfy its Spinning Reserve Service obligation. To the extent the Control Area operator performs this service for the Transmission Provider, charges to the Transmission Customer are to reflect only a pass-through of the costs charged to the Transmission Provider by that Control Area operator.

The charges for this service where NPPD is providing the service to the Transmission Provider shall be as set forth below. The charges shall apply to the amount of Reserved Capacity as defined in the Southwest Power Pool (SPP) Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT) for Transmission Customer's Point-to-Point transactions, and to the Transmission Customer's actual monthly Network Load for each month determined in accordance with Part III of the SPP OATT for Network Service transactions.

1. Monthly delivery: \$0.11/kW
2. Weekly delivery: \$0.025/kW
3. Daily delivery: \$0.0051/kW
4. Hourly delivery: \$0.00032/kW
